

AIMPOINT CompM4

Since 1997, over 500,000 Aimpoint sights have been delivered to the U.S. Army, and many thousands more are in use by other elite military forces around the world. Early in 2006, the U.S. Army tested sights from the top optics manufacturers in the world, and again selected Aimpoint to supply the Army's new M68 CCO (Close-Combat Optic). This new sight, the Aimpoint CompM4, continues Aimpoint's tradition of building the most rugged, reliable and easy to use optics available to today's fighting forces.

With 7 night vision compatible switch settings and band-pass lens coating for compatibility with all generations of night vision device (NVD), the CompM4 is ready for use around the clock. The CompM4 holds up under the roughest physical handling and can withstand the most severe weather conditions and temperatures. In fact, the CompM4 is completely submersible and will withstand pressures up to 2.5 atmospheres allowing it to be taken up to 25 meters underwater.

The integral modular mounting system eliminates the need for a separate ring and ensures that the sight can not rotate within the ring. Low profile adjustments make the CompM4 more snag-proof than the CompM2 and the 16 position switch provides more brightness settings for increased versatility in any light condition.



Since the CompM4 uses standard AA batteries of any chemistry, replacements are nearly universally available and inexpensive. With 8 years of continuous use at the 12th of 16 brightness settings on a standard Alkaline AA battery, the user can count on the CompM4 to always be ready when it is needed. Using a lithium AA battery provides even longer battery life and improved performance in cold temperatures. While it is primarily used by armed forces, hunters and sport shooters who demand absolutely the most rugged sight available also use the CompM4.
